

## SCOPE OF WORK

**TITLE: HEALTH ECONOMIST EXPERT**  
**UNIT: FOOD POLICY PROJECT**

### I. BACKGROUND/ PURPOSE

- The Food Policy Project at CISDI requires a Health Economist Expert, specializing in cost-effectiveness analysis, to support a quantitative study on the impact of sweetened and sugary beverages (SSBs) taxes on Burden of Diseases in Indonesia.
- The Expert is responsible for overseeing and advising the research process to ensure the research is robust and rigorously done
- The Expert must not work or be affiliated with any food, beverage, or alcohol companies
- The Expert works with the Food Policy project at CISDI in coordination with funders, external stakeholders and other assigned experts (if any) from June 2023 to December 2023.
- The main role of the Expert is to assist the activities of the Research team at CISDI Food Policy project in 1) study design, 2) establishing research methods, 3) identifying data sources, 4) overseeing the research process, 5) conducting quality controls of research outputs, and 6) research dissemination.

### II. ACTIVITIES/DELIVERABLES

- The Expert is expected to work at least 3 days per month (approximately 21 working hours), including attending 3-4 monthly meetings with the team (negotiable).
